Key responsibilities

The User Acceptance Testing Analyst Junior is responsible for the quality of deliveries s/he is assigned to validate. His/her job is to methodically plan and execute test scenarios to ascertain the level of quality of a defined software scope. The Acceptance Tester will work closely with the Project Manager and/or other User Acceptance Testing Analysts to ensure that the scope and schedule of his/her assignments are met.

As full-time User Acceptance Testing Analyst Junior your missions will primarily include:

- Plan the test cycle, within the allotted time and scope of the project plan
- Create and/or revise existing test cases to be used in a test cycle
- Ensure traceability of test cases to requirement scope in accordance with the Project Manager
- Provide feedback on the quality of the delivery by executing the allocated test cases and logging defects for issues found
- Support the end users in validating that their business requirements often expressed as new change requests have been met
- Coordinate and collaborate with the project teams, both internal and external as to achieve a successful customer acceptance test conclusion.
- Work closely with testing peers, during each testing cycle to ensure smooth communication and efficient resolution of each issue encountered
- Contribute to the continued development of the Loterie Nationale's test process and team knowledge
- Participate in the elaboration process of user requirements.
